

IFISC (CSIC-UIB) SCHOLARSHIPS 2022-23 Mobility Grants FOR STUDENTS OF THE MASTER IN PHYSICS OF COMPLEX SYSTEMS

GENERAL RULES

1. The grants are aimed to those students who wish to pursue the Master in Physics of Complex Systems at the University of the Balearic Islands during the academic course 2022-23.

2. The scholarship will amount a total of \in 6,000 (six thousand euros), in two installments: \in 4,000 at the beginning of the first semester, after the student has actually enrolled in the master, and \in 2,000 in December 2022. One of these scholarships is sponsored by the Sicomoro Foundation.

3. The scholarship is aimed at covering all or part of the costs of travel and living (including cost of food and accommodation) detailed in the application of the selected students.

4. Additionally, the selected fellows will be exempt from paying tuition fees.

5. The granting of this aid shall not establish any contractual or statutory relationship between the University of the Balearic Islands or CSIC and the beneficiary.

6. The Selection Committee will consist of the following IFISC members: the director of the Master in Physics of Complex Systems, acting as chairman, a representative of the SICOMORO Foundation, and three faculty members appointed by the board of studies, as well as a representative of the Centre for Postgraduate Studies,

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications must be submitted electronically using the form available at the website https://ifisc.uib-csic.es/master/fellowships. To be considered for the scholarships the applicant must upload the required documents using the preenrolment form at

https://cep.uib.eu/en/Com_hi_puc_accedir/Preinscripcio/.

The following documentation must be attached:

1.- Copy of ID card or passport.

2.- Personal academic certificate, including the topics covered and the grades obtained.

3.- Curriculum Vitae.

4.- A brief description of the interest in pursuing this Master and a justification of the need for the support of mobility costs.

5.- Two university professors who know the candidate must send letters of reference supporting the application to master@ifisc.uib-csic.es

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

The Selection Committee will evaluate applications on the basis of the documentation presented, with emphasis on the academic record, the curriculum vitae and the need for a mobility aid. The SICOMORO fellowship will be selected by the Fundación SICOMORO amongst the candidates preselected by the Selection Committee.

OBLIGATIONS OF THE BENEFICIARY

1.- The beneficiaries must accept in writing (using the **Annex** document) the rules and conditions of the grants, within seven calendar days of notice. The resolution will be published in the webpage and sent to the email address indicated on the application.

2.- In case of resignation or any substantial change affecting the conditions of the application, the beneficiaries must communicate in writing to the Centre for Graduate Studies.

3.- The recipient of the grant sponsored by the Sicomoro Foundation must contribute three entries (one per quarter) to be published on the complex systems blog of The Sicomoro Foundation (maximum 1500 words).

CANCELLATION OR WITHDRAWAL

Will invalidate the Scholarship:

-The voluntary withdrawal or dropout from the studies.

-Not showing up at the center at most a week after the beginning of classes. -The finding of an irregularity in the data provided in the request.

The cancellation will imply the loss of all rights attached to the scholarship.

DECISION

The decision taken by the Selection Committee will be communicated to the applicants to the email address listed in their applications. A first decision will be announced by July 25 (2022) and will consider those applications received by July 18 (2022). Should some fellowships not be awarded then, a second decision will be announced by October 3 (2022) and will consider all applications received by September 26 (2022).
