

IFISC (CSIC-UIB) SCHOLARSHIPS 2025-26

FOR STUDENTS OF THE MASTER IN PHYSICS OF COMPLEX SYSTEMS

The purpose of this call is to award **four scholarships** for the completion of the Master in Physics of Complex Systems at the University of the Balearic Islands during the academic course 2025-26.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The grants are aimed to those students who wish to pursue the Master in Physics of Complex Systems at the University of the Balearic Islands during the academic course 2025-26.
- 2. The selected fellows will be exempt from paying tuition fees.
- 3. Additionally, for applicants who are non-residents of Mallorca at the time of application, the scholarship will cover:
 - 3.1. Travel expenses up to a maximum value of €500.
 - 3.2. Living costs with a total grant of €7,000 (seven thousand euros), distributed in two installments: €4,000 at the beginning of the first semester, following the student's official enrollment in the master's program, and €3,000 at the start of the second semester. One of these grants is sponsored by the SICOMORO Foundation.
- 4. The granting of this aid shall not establish any contractual or statutory relationship between the University of the Balearic Islands or CSIC and the beneficiary.
- 5. The Selection Committee will consist of the following IFISC members: three faculty appointed by the board of studies, one of them acting as chairman, a representative of the SICOMORO Foundation as well as a representative of the UIB Centre for Postgraduate Studies.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications must be submitted electronically using the form available at the website ifisc.uib-csic.es/master/fellowships. To be considered for the scholarships, the applicant must be pre-enrolled in the master program following the instructions and fill the pre-enrolment form at https://cep.uib.eu/en/Com_hi_puc_accedir/Preinscripcio/

The deadline for applications is July 13th 2025.

The following documentation must be attached:

1.- Copy of ID card or passport.

2.- Personal academic certificate, including the topics covered and the grades obtained.

3.- Curriculum Vitae that includes contact information (specifically phone and email).

4.- A one page statement of the interest in pursuing this specific Master.

5.- Two reference letters supporting the application must be sent to master@ifisc.uib-csic.es

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

The Selection Committee will evaluate applications on the basis of the documentation presented, with emphasis on the academic record, the curriculum vitae and their motivation for this specific master's program. A total of four scholarships are being offered; however, the committee reserves the right to leave some of them unawarded if deemed appropriate. The SICOMORO fellowship will be selected by the SICOMORO Foundation amongst three candidates pre-selected by the Selection Committee. Upon closure of the call, the candidates could be contacted to schedule an interview.

OBLIGATIONS OF THE BENEFICIARY

1. Acceptance of Grant Terms:

Beneficiaries are required to formally accept the rules and conditions of the grant in writing by completing and submitting the Annex document provided. This acceptance must be completed within four (4) calendar days from the date of notification. The resolution will be published on the official website and communicated via email to the address specified in the application.

2. Notification of Resignation or Changes:

In the event of resignation or any significant changes that may affect the conditions of the grant, beneficiaries must promptly notify the UIB Centre for

Postgraduate Studies in writing. Failure to communicate such changes may result in the revocation of the grant or other administrative actions.

3. Contribution Requirements for SICOMORO Foundation Grants:

Recipients of grants sponsored by the SICOMORO Foundation are obligated to contribute three (3) blog entries (one per quarter) to be published on the Complex Systems Blog of the SICOMORO Foundation. Each entry must not exceed 1,500 words. Additionally, applicants for the SICOMORO Foundation grant must demonstrate a minimum proficiency level of C1 in Spanish or its equivalent, as this is essential for fulfilling the contribution requirements.

CANCELLATION OR WITHDRAWAL

Will invalidate the Scholarship:

-The voluntary withdrawal or dropout from the studies.

-Failure to maintain regular attendance throughout the program or fulfill minimum academic requirements (including non-attendance of exams, failure to submit mandatory coursework).

-The finding of an irregularity in the data provided in the request.

The cancellation will imply the loss of all rights attached to the scholarship.

DECISION

The decision taken by the Selection Committee will be communicated to the applicants to the email address listed in their applications. A first decision will be announced before July 22th 2025 and will consider those applications received before July 14th 2025.
